ABSTRACT

The problem of poverty in D.I Yogyakarta Province is the relatively high number of poverty, this poses a challenge for local governments in overcoming poverty. This study aims to determine the effect of Unemployment, Education and GRDP on poverty in the Province of D.I Yogyakarta. This study uses secondary data and is sourced from the Indonesian Central Statistics Agency. The time series data used in this study is 2011 to 2021 with cross-sectional data of 5 districts/cities in D.I Yogyakarta Province. The analysis used in this study uses static panel data analysis.

Overall, the results of the study indicate that the Unemployment variable has no significant effect on poverty in the Province of D.I Yogyakarta. Education has a negative and significant effect on poverty in the Province of D.I Yogyakarta. Other results show that GRDP has a negative and significant effect on poverty in the Province of D.I Yogyakarta.
