

ABSTRACT

Unemployment is a problem that caused decreasing in people's welfare. The economic slowdown that occurred in 2020, causes an increase in the amount of unemployment. This study aims to analyze the effect of education, provincial minimum wage, and economic growth on the amount of unemployment in Indonesia.

This study used panel data, consisting of cross section between 33 provinces in Indonesia and time series data set in 2013-2022. The dependent variable is the amount of unemployment. The independent variables are education, provincial minimum wage, and economic growth. The analytical method used in this study is the Fixed Effect Model (FEM).

The result of this study showed that education had a positive and significant effect on the amounts of unemployed. The provincial minimum wage and economic growth had negative and significant effect on unemployment. Education has the most effect on increasing the amount of unemployment.
