ABSTRACT

Extreme poverty is a serious problem for all governments in Indonesia, and the Rembang Regency is no exception. Kaliombo Village is the village with the highest extreme poverty in Sulang Sub-district, Rembang Regency. This study aims to look at the main determinants of extreme poverty in Kaliombo Village, Sulang Rembang Regency. This study uses primary data obtained from a research questionnaire with 100 Kaliombo villagers as respondents. The analysis model used was binary logistic regression.

The results showed that partially, income, education, house asset ownership, other asset ownership and outlook on life had a significant effect on extreme poverty in Kaliombo Village, while early marriage and employment status had no significant effect on extreme poverty in Kaliombo Village. However, simultaneously, income, education, early marriage, employment status, home asset ownership, other asset ownership and outlook on life have a significant effect on extreme poverty in Kaliombo Village.
