ABSTRACT

Dhoopar introduced an integrated conceptual model of organizational effectiveness (OE) that considers the levels of antecedents (individual, group, and organizational) as well as measures of (financial, operational, structural, and attitudinal). This research aims to analyze company effectiveness using that model through a multi-case study of shrimp processing companies in Central Java Province. This research uses a qualitative methodology. Thefindings of this study can help decision makers and stakeholders in adopting, designing and implementing proactive internal control systems to improve operational efficiency, effectiveness and competitive advantage. Because this research concentrates on fish processing companies that have different characteristics, the conclusions may be limited.
