

ABSTRACT

The Zakat Village Index is a mechanism tool used to measure the condition of a village to be said to be eligible or not worthy of being assisted by zakat funds. The purpose of this research is to find out whether Mluweh Village is a village that is eligible to distribute productive zakat program funds.

This research is a type of exploratory research. Meanwhile, the approach used is a mixed methods research approach that combines qualitative and quantitative methods. Data was collected by means of direct surveys, as well as interviews obtained from informants. Furthermore, the data will be processed by calculating the Multi-Stage Weigh Index by multiplying the five components of the zakat village index.

The results of the calculation of the Mluweh Village IDZ obtained a value of 0.555, this means that the condition of the village is good enough so that it can be considered properly. The economic dimension has the lowest index value with a value of 0.26, this shows that the economic conditions in the village are very weak so that assistance is prioritized. The productive zakat program that can assist in this field is the development of agri-business potential such as processed household products made from bananas.
