

ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the effect of the labour, fisheries, and fishing vessels on Gross Regional Domestic Product, and also to know how slavery conditions in the sub sector of fisheries in Indonesia. The research period analyzed was between 2016-2020.

This study uses secondary data obtained from the Statistics Indonesia (BPS), The Statistical and Information Center of the Ministry of the Ocean and Fisheries, International Organization for Migration (IOM), and the International Labour Organization (ILO). The method used is descriptive quantitative analysis methods, by regression panel data.

Based on the results of the study by doing regression analysis on labour variables, fishing companies and the fishing vessels against the growth rate of fisheries, indicate that labour and fishing vessels significantly affects the fisheries growth rate and the variable fishing companies isn't significantly affecting the fisheries growth rate in Indonesia during 2016-2020.
