

ABSTRACK

The purpose of the this research is to analyze the impact of gender equality on economic growth. The dependent variable ini this study is economic growth. The independent variable in this study is gender equality. There are three control variable in this study, firm size, leverage, and profitability.

The research population consists of commercial banks listed with the Financial Services Authority (OJK) in the Indonesian Banking Statistics (SPI) released from 2021 to 2023. The sampling technique used is purposive sampling, resulting in 141 financial reports that meet the criteria. The hypothesis was then tested using multiple regression analysis with the SPSS 29 software.

The result of this study indicate gender equality does not affect economic growth.
