## **ABSTRACT**

This study analyzes factors that affect inclusive economic growth in Indonesia from 2017-2021 using data from the National Development Planning Agency (BAPPENAS). The study aims to identify factors that affect inclusive economic growth, including local government control, poverty, unemployment, human development index, domestic direct investment, foreign direct investment, population growth, and capital expenditure. The research method is a descriptive quantitative analysis using panel data from 34 provinces in Indonesia. The results of the study show that local government oversight, poverty, Human Development Index (HDI), and population growth have a significant impact on overall economic growth.
