

## **ABSTRACT**

*One of the goals of the government program is to improve the quality of Human Resources by providing access to education for all levels of society and increasing school participation rates. The policy adopted by the Indonesian government to improve the quality of education for all people is through the provision of education subsidies. The goal of the education subsidy program is to increase the Gross Enrolment Rate (GER). This study focuses on analyzing the influence of the School Operational Assistance (BOS) program, education budget, Gross Regional Domestic Product percapita and Gross Enrolment Rate (GER) of the previous year to Gross Enrolment Rate (GER) at the Elementary School, Junior High School and Senior High School. in the Regency/City of Central Java Province in 2015-2017.*

*This research is a quantitative analysis using Panel Fixed Effect Model (FEM) data estimation. Research results show that at the elementary school level education budget and Gross Enrolment Rate (GER) of the previous year have a positive and significant effect on Gross Enrolment Rate (GER).*

*At the Junior High School level, Gross Regional Domestic Product percapita and Gross Enrolment Rate (GER) of the previous year has positive significant impact to Gross Enrolment Rate (GER),*

*At the Senior High School level, School Operational Assistance (BOS) program, education budget and Gross Regional Domestic Product percapita has positive significant impact to Gross Enrolment Rate (GER),*
