

ABSTRACT

This research aims to find out whether Regional Original Income and Balancing Funds, namely Profit Sharing Funds, General Allocation Funds and Special Allocation Funds, have an effect on Economic Growth in Nabire Regency.

The data used in this research is secondary data in the form of Nabire Regency panel data for the 2010-2021 period. The data source used in this research was obtained from the Central Statistics Agency (BPS). The research method used in this research uses multiple linear regression analysis tools.

The results of this research show that: (1) Regional Original Income has a significant effect on Economic Growth. (2) Profit Sharing Funds have no effect on Economic Growth. (3) General Allocation Funds have no effect on Economic Growth. (4) Special Allocation Funds have a significant effect on Economic Growth.
