

## **ABSTRACT**

*This research discusses the fiqh law on the low distribution of productive zakat at BAZNAS in Kudus Regency. The background of this study is based on the differences in opinion among fiqh scholars regarding the law of productive zakat. These differences among fiqh scholars have caused the community to be cautious about productive zakat.*

*This research uses a descriptive qualitative approach, which identifies the condition of objects to draw general conclusions. Data was collected through interviews and documentation from scholars in Kudus, the Head of the Ministry of Religious Affairs of Kudus Regency, and staff of BAZNAS Kudus Regency.*

*The results of this research indicate that productive zakat fiqh law is not the cause of low productive zakat at BAZNAS in Kudus Regency. The conclusion of this study suggests that there is a need for direct communication from BAZNAS about productive zakat to prospective mustahiq, as well as improving and developing productive zakat distribution programs to empower and improve the welfare of mustahiq.*
