ABSTRACT

This study aimed to analyze the effect of leadership, organizational commitment, and sanction to player discipline on Venus Futsal Academy Semarang.

The population used in this study were 52 players of Venus Futsal Academy Semarang. The technique sampling used is purposive sampling technique. Data collection used by questionnaire method. The analytical method used is multiple regression analysis.

In the classical assumption, there are no symptoms multicoloniarity, does not occur heterocedastity, and normal distribution of data. The variables of discipline in effected by variables of leadership, commitment and sanction amounting to 77,6%. The results appeared that leadership, commitment, and sanction has positive and significant effect to player discipline on Venus Futsal Academy Semarang.
