## **ABSTRACT**

The research aims to determine the influence about Gross Domestic Regional Product (GDRP), investment, inflation, and minimum wage to employment of Semarang city period 1995-2015. The analytical method that is used in this thesis is multiple linear regression or ordinary least square(OLS), with time series 1995-2015 and this thesis used is secondary data.

The results of the analysis showed that Gross Domestic Regional Product (GDRP), and investment have a positive and signifikan influence to employment of Semarang city, we can conclude a higher level Gross Domestic Regional Product (GDRP), and investment, hence higher level to employment of Semarang city. On the other side, a inflation have a negative and unsignificant to employment of Semarang city. A part of that, minimum wage have a negative and significant to employment of Semarang city. We can conclude a higher level inflation and minimum wage, hence a lower level to employment of Semarang city. With the R<sup>2</sup> value of 0,754, which means that 75,4 percent of the dependent variable explanatory. While the remaining 24,6 percent is explained by the other variables outside the model used.
