ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the influence of Intelletual Capital on Financial Performance of Islamic Banking in Indonesia. This study uses a Pulic Method $(VAIC^{TM})$ in measuring the performance of Intellectual Capital as the independent variable. ROA and ROE is a proxy of financial performance as the dependent variable.

This research uses purposive sampling method to determine the study sample to be used. Study sample consisted of 50 quarterly reports from 7 (seven) Islamic Banking in Indonesia from 2008 to 2010.

Results showed that overall there is significant influence between the Intellectual Capital ($VAIC^{TM}$) with Financial Performance (ROA and ROE). However, if the measurements performed on the components of the $VAIC^{TM}$ (CEE, HCE and SCE) then only CEE component that has a significant influence on ROE.
