

ABSTRACT

The existence of the Islamic Economics in recent years has experienced a high increase. This increase is in line with the increasing amount of literature on Islamic Economics. The increase of this literature makes increasingly diverse developments in the science of Islamic Economics. This needs to be addressed with a wise attitude; one of them is by examining various points of view, including the thoughts of the figures about the Islamic Economic System, so that the knowledge about the Islamic Economic System is fundamentally shared by various parties.

This research uses a qualitative method with library research with a comparative approach. This library research explains and compares the thoughts of two contemporary Islamic Economic figures namely Syed Nawab Haider Naqvi and Yusuf Al-Qardhawi. Data analysis techniques used are content analysis (comparative analysis). Data can be obtained by reviewing books, scientific works in print or electronic form, and all other written material. The author describes the two research objects and analyzes them and then compares the results of the two objects by combining several dimensions of the contents of these two objects. The author uses the union intersection tool to compare several dimensions of the thoughts of the two figures regarding the Islamic Economic System.

The results shows that Syed Nawab Haider Naqvi and Yusuf Al-Qardhawi's thoughts about the Islamic Economic System were classified into the same or similar dimensions. The thoughts of these two Islamic Economic figures are related to one another. Both figures agreed to integrate Islamic norms and ethics originating from the Qur'an and Hadith in every economic activity.
