

ABSTRACT

The level of female labor force participation in Indonesia has increased every year. Challenges of single parent female workers, they must divide their time to caring for their families and household chores.

This study analyzes the factors of age, education, working hours, employment status and family dependents that influence the income of single parent female workers. In Semarang city, a hundred respondents spread in the district of Pedurungan, West Semarang, South Semarang and Tembalang were examined using Multiple Linear Regression methods.

This result seen from age, education level, working hours, employment status and family dependents shows that are positively and significantly, the income of single parent female workers is also undergoing improvement.
