ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to determine how the psychological well-being conditions of informal workers in the SMEs creative industry sector in the city of Semarang, especially in Kampung Batik Semarang. This study uses 6 dimensions of psychological well-being. This study uses a qualitative method with a phenomenological approach and includes several of batik craftmen as participants who participated in this study. Retrieval of data using in-depth interviews conducted directly to the participants.

The results of the study showed that all participants had psychological wellbeing that was influenced by each dimension. But specifically, it is known that there are two dimensions that most influence the psychological well-being of informal workers there, including the dimension of positive relations with others and the dimension of environmental mastery.
