Strategic alignment is the relationship between information systems plans with business plans.

Using survey data from middle management and top management with data collection of responder by post. The analytical tool is used Partial Least Square based on Structural Equational Modelling And SmartPLS software.

Result of this research which confirm research of Nofie Iman and Jogiyanto, that the organization's performance is influenced by strategic alignment, business strategy and IS/IT strategy. Meanwhile strategic alignment is influenced by business strategy and IS/IT strategy. Thereby can be concluded that organizational performance is still affected by the alignment between business strategy and IS/IT strategy.
