ABSTRACK

The purpose of the research is to analyze the effect of the dark triad personality on ethical financial reporting choices. The dark triad factors used in this study are narcissism, machiavellianism, and psychopathy.

The population of the research are Accountant Profession Education students throughout Indonesia. The sampling method of this research is uses purposive sampling with 137 total samples from Diponegoro University, Stikubank University, and Gadjah Mada University.

This research uses multiple regression to test the hypothesis. The results of this research shows that each characteristics of the dark triad personality has a significant negative effect on ethical financial reporting choices.
