ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine level of society participation and constraints infrastructure development in Jogonegoro Village, Mertoyudan District, Magelang Regency, Central Java.

The method used is qualitative descriptive. Data obtained by survey, interview and questionnaire. Sampling in this study with probability sampling technique that is proportionate stratified random sampling using the Slovin formula and obtained a sample of 98 respondents, then analyzed descriptively.

The results of this study show that level of society participation in development Jogonegoro Village, Mertoyudan Subdistrict, Magelang District, is seen from five internal and external constraints participation, namely development initiative constraint 29.05% or located in low category, financing development constraint 32.08% or located in low category, development decision making constraint 37.60% or located in low category, energy mobility constraint 42.14% or located in middle category, implementation of activities constraint 40.33% or located in low category. The percentage of internal and external constraints to village development society participation in Jogonegoro Village is classified as moderate with an average score of 42.14%. As for what affects the constraints to participation in Jogonegoro Village are awareness / willingness, age, gender, education and income.
