ABSTRAC

This study aims to provide a description of the motivations that lead to fraud in the police. The case that occurred at Polda Z is an example of motivation influencing a member to commit fraud.

This study uses a qualitative approach, using qualitative research methods. This study seeks to describe the motivations that make police officers commit fraudulent acts. The data used in this study are primary data and secondary data. Data collection was carried out by direct interviews with the perpetrators and several other sources, observing and analyzing additional files. The collected data will be analyzed using data reduction analysis techniques, data display, and conclusions.

The findings in this study reveal the motivations that appear in the police force, there are 2 motivations that influence a member to commit fraud. A hedonistic lifestyle and being ready to be commander / ready to carry out are the main triggers for fraud.
