

ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the factors that affect the interests of labor migration in the industrial area of Semarang and a case study in the LIK Bugangan Baru Semarang. As an industrial area with a number of units and the largest workforce in the city of Semarang course there are things that attract labor to work in that place. Socioeconomic disparity led to the emergence of social economic problems both in rural and urban that the problem is relatively more diverse. The problems that emerged one of them is, the emergence of the phenomenon of circular labor decisions. This study uses primary data from the questionnaire with a list of questions that had been prepared. A total of 125 people as respondents to the method of data retrieval from data Industry Directory Large and Middle 2010 from BPS Central Java Province.

Analysis techniques in this study using the Tobit regression method using Eviews software, where the independent variables used were age variable, net income, education level, marital status, employment status and gender of respondents, while for the dependent variable of this study is the intention of circular labor migration employment. By using an error rate of 5% showed that the variables that affect the interests of circular migration of labor is the variable age (prob. 0.0260), net income (prob. 0.0000), education level (Prob. 0.0349), status marriage (prob. 0.0125) and variable work in the area of origin (prob. 0.0460).
